CAMPFIRE SAFETY

No fires are to be lit on the camping grounds grass. Fire baskets and half oil drum BBQs can be hired if needed.

Persons found burning rubbish, plastic or any toxic materials will be asked to leave the site immediately; only the burning of paper, card and wood is allowed.

Fire Trays/Baskets or BBQs must only be emptied on to the sites two large campfire circles or left for staff collection following your departure.

DO NOT EMPTY HOT ASH ON TO THE GRASS OR IN HEDGEROWS!!!

Do NOT overload fire baskets; it is not a competition to see how high you can get your flames.

The use of any flammable fuels is prohibited when lighting campfires (petrol or spirits).

If you do use any instant disposable BBQs on the camping field, make sure that they are off the grass and are not placed near any tents or waste bags when finished with.

Please ensure any surplus wood is returned to the woodpiles before your departure.

There is to be NO felling of standing timber as green wood will not burn well and will smoke a lot. Wood is expensive and if wasted we reserve the right to make any additional charges.

Never leave your BBQ or campfire unsupervised! All under 18s must be supervised by a responsible adult when having campfires.

Strictly NO turf or trenches are to be dug for fires.

Do not attempt to move your hired fire baskets or BBQs when they are lit. Always allow them to cool first; skin will stick to hot metal. Inform KICC staff of any fire basket collections prior to your departure.

If a member of K.I.C.C. staff witnesses any abuse or misuse of any knives, axes or saws within the site, they are authorised to request the item and it will be returned only to the leaders in charge.

Wind directions do change abruptly because of the location of this campsite, so please do your best not to smoke out your neighbours when having campfires or cooking; the greener the wood the more it will smoke.

The two large group campfire circles are free to use but you must notify a member of our staff of any times and dates your group wishes to use them. Fire circles are for nighttime use only.

Fire circles must be vacated and left to burn out after 11pm. Do not fuel the fires after this time!

The No 1 rule is to always have fun and enjoy your self in a safe manner. Please help us to make your stay with us here at Kingsdown a safe happy and enjoyably experience.

Tips for lighting your campfire: Screw up your newspaper into tennis ball sized pieces, place in the fire basket and light. Add small kindling and slowly build your fire up with larger kindling.

Remember to start small and progressively add kindling to reach an adequate sized campfire.

CAMPSITE RULES

No vehicle must exceed 10 mph whilst driving through "The Avenue" to the camping centre or whilst on the Camping Grounds.

Good relationships are maintained with our neighbours by mutual respect and understanding. All guests are expected to uphold this arrangement. (Those who don't will be asked to leave).

You are expected to ensure members of your group are quiet in their areas between the hours of 11pm & 7am as we try to promote a family and not a festival style atmosphere.

All waste must be recycled and separated using the blue bins provided near the site office. Love the site - LEAVE NO TRACE. Alternatively, take your non-recycled waste home with you. Persons found dumping will be charged.

To avoid annoying others please refrain from playing any loud music or radios, unless permission is granted by site staff.

Bicycles/motorbikes should also not be ridden around the site to the annoyance of other campers and near-by neighbours.

Site Staff MUST be informed of the operation of any generators. (Use of ANY generators after 10:30pm is strictly prohibited).

Vehicle use on the camping field is down to management discretion and weather permitting. Remember that there are young children about so no vehicle must exceed 10 mph whilst driving on the camping field.

Ensure that all vehicles are parked horizontally whilst on the camping field. Vehicle use must be kept to a minimum; do not drive to and from the toilet block; only use your vehicle when leaving the site.

No fires are to be lit on the grass! Alter fires/Fire trays/drums and BBQs can be hired if needed.

Fire Trays and BBQs must ONLY be emptied on to the site's 2 large Camp Fire Circles, or left for staff collection following your departure. (Do NOT empty into hedgerows).

Please ensure any surplus wood is returned to the piles before your departure. The site should be cleared by noon on the day of your departure unless permitted otherwise.

Wood is available at the designated wood piles adjacent to the site's two large campfire circles. No turf or trenches are to be dug! Pitches should be left as they are found.

The large campfire circles are free to use but you must notify a member of our staff of any times and dates your group wishes to use them. (Both Fire Circles must be vacated and left to burn out by 11pm).

If a member of site staff witnesses any abuse or misuse of any knives, axes or saws within the site, they are authorised to request the item and it will be returned only to the leader in charge.

The toilet block and wash facilities must be left clean and tidy after use. Do NOT leave rubbish bags in the toilet blocks or around the campsite = magnets for seagulls.

Urinating in areas other than the toilet block is strictly prohibited. Persons caught doing so will be asked to leave immediately (lazy, obscene and stupid behaviour will not be tolerated).

Do not wash cooking utensils/equipment in the toilet block or directly under the water stand pipes around the fields; please use the stainless steel sinks outside of toilet blocks.

Groups will be charged for any damage that any member of their group incurs. Leaders are held responsible for their own groups, which must be supervised at all times. Unruly behaviour will not be tolerated.

If any member of your group observes something out of place, please ensure the information is passed on to a member of site staff.

We do not allow dogs/pets on site apart from guide or trained rescue dogs.

Always ensure that you close the beach gate behind you.

The site should be cleared by noon on the day of your departure unless permitted otherwise by our staff. Any time spent on the site after noon will incur our day rate fees.

Please ensure that you have all your camping equipment before you depart the site, including tent pegs which cause damage to our mowers and injuries if left in the ground. (LEAVE NO TRACE)

KICC reserves the right to instruct any camper to disconnect any electrical equipment that does not meet recommended electrical safety standards.

KICC will be responsible for the safety of the electric system to the electric socket on the hook-up point. It is the responsibility of the user to ensure that the mains electrical cable from the hook-up point to the unit and the unit's installations are safe (e.g. making sure that the cable is pegged down and that the unit is up to date with recommended electrical safety standards).
