CAMPSITE RULES

No Vehicle should ever exceed 10mph while on this campsite!

Unless permission is granted by our staff Vehicles are not permitted on the grass (except for initial unloading and final loading)

Remember that there are young children about, so cars/vans must be left in the free on site car park as much as possible.

Please recycle all of you waste, bins for separating your rubbish are available. Do not leave rubbish bags in and around the toilet blocks.

The toilet block and wash facilities must be left clean and tidy after use.

Do not wash cooking utensils/equipment in the toilet block or directly under the water stand pipes around the fields; please use the stainless steel sinks outside of toilet blocks.

The site should be cleared by noon on the day of your departure unless permitted otherwise by our staff. Any time spent on site after 12:00 noon may incur our day rate fees.

Please ensure that you have all your camping equipment before you depart the site. This includes tent pegs which can cause damage to our mowers and injuries if left in the ground.

Leaders are held responsible for their own groups, which must be supervised at all times. Unruly behaviour will not be tolerated. Persistent offenders will be asked to leave the camp site.

Groups or individuals will be charged for any damage that they or any member of their group incurs.

If any member of your group observes something out of place, please ensure that the information is passed on to a member of our staff.

Good relationships are maintained with our neighbours by mutual respect and understanding. All users of our camp site are expected to up hold this arrangement.

KICC will be responsible for the safety of the electric system to the outlet socket on the hook-up points. It is the responsibility of the user to ensure that the mains electrical cable from the hook-up point to the unit and the unit's installations are safe (e.g. making sure that the cable is pegged down and that the unit is up to date with recommended electrical safety standards)

KICC also reserve the right to instruct any campers to disconnect any electrical equipment that does not meet recommended electrical safety standards.

You are expected to ensure members of your group are quiet in their areas between 22:30hrs & 07:00hrs, unless permission is granted by a member of our staff for any night time activities.

Please refrain from playing any music/radios or the usage of generators after 10:30pm.

Bicycles should not be ridden around the site to the annoyance of other campers.

Always ensure that you close the beach gate behind you.
